

VI. MISCELLANEOUS CURRICULA

Introduction

The competencies listed in Section VI are important to be mastered by every resident. Most of them are taught in many, if not all, rotations without any one rotation having the predominant responsibility. The competencies are listed for reference for both residents and faculty. Greater detail is provided where a given rotation makes these competencies a major focus for its training.

Teaching methods are discussed where the competencies are the predominant focus of the rotation.

Suggested readings are frequently supplied to the sub headings.

The evaluation of the effectiveness of this aspect of the education occurs on each rotation and is addressed in the semi-annual evaluation of each resident by the Program Director.

This approach will be evaluated at the end of 2001 with discussions throughout the year as to how to measure its success.
